

Definition of “recognized apprenticeship in carpentry” is:

A carpentry apprenticeship consists of a minimum of work hours and related instructional classes taken at a carpenter’s training center. After completion and achievement of a passing grade, the apprentice will hold a Certificate of Apprenticeship, Certificate of Qualification or Certificate of Completion.

Local program work hours and instructional classes requirements may vary from area to area, therefore please contact individual programs for more information.
