<b>2</b>	<b>Assessing individuals utilizing standardized psychological testing instruments.</b>
<b>3</b>	<b>Writing comprehensive psychological reports.</b>
<b>4</b>	<b>Communicating orally (e.g., public speaking, oral presentations, expert witness testimony) persuasively in reference to psychological issues.</b>
<b>5</b>	<b>Integrating multiple sources of psychological data for the purpose of assessing individuals.</b>
<b>6</b>	<b>Conducting psychological research or reviewing psychological research findings.</b>
<b>7</b>	<b>Interviewing patients or individuals for the purpose of making clinical or employment recommendations.</b>
