“Equivalent to graduation from college...”

- Equivalent to graduation from college means that you have completed a bachelor’s degree from an accredited college or university, or that you possess a letter from the college or university stating that you have met all of the academic requirements for graduation. You must show your degree or letter at the time you are being considered for appointment.
